Personal, Social & Emotional Development

We will be encouraging the children to make their own choices, selecting their own activities and resources.

We will be encouraging the children to demonstrate friendly behaviour, playing alongside and with other children, building friendships.

Help your child by: playing turn taking games with your child to help them to develop their social skills.

Literacy

We will continue to share stories daily with the children, We will have lots of different opportunities to write and make marks for a purpose such as making maps, writing invitations.

Help your child by: showing your child you are a reader and a writer by making sure they see you write shopping lists, messages and cards. This will encourage them to follow your lead!

Share stories with your children, encourage them to join in and predict what may happen next.

Expressive Arts and Design

The children will be acting out various stories and scenarios around our theme of adventures; especially superheroes. We will be continuing to explore a variety of creative activities and use our imagination in our work. We will be making vegetable people and sock puppets as well as props to support our role play - maps, wands, crowns and superhero props.

We will continue to learn more new songs and dances; we look forward to sharing these with you.

Help your child by: encouraging your child to retell stories after reading a favourite book. Let your child perform songs and rhymes to family and friends.

This term we will be going on lots of magical journeys. We will be sharing stories about superheroes (Supertato), prince and princesses and mystical creatures, fairies, dragons and monsters. We will also be looking at books by the author Sue Hendra.

Sharing stories is such a great way to support your child's learning so we would love to hear about their favourites from home too!

Communication and Language

We are going to spend lots of time taking part in role-play and acting out stories. We will be using new vocabulary and exploring different situations using props to help. We will be talking and listening to each other one to one and in small groups, taking turns to listen and talk.

Help your child by: we will continue to upload observations onto Tapestry so please share your child's learning journey with them at home.
