Dear Parents and Carers,

We've had an excellent first term and can't wait for the learning to come! I hope you all had a restful holiday and are ready to dive into the new half term.

We will be learning about Vikings and the impact of their settlement in Britain. We will be studying their actions and behaviour which will enable us to understand their legacy on how Britain is today. In Science, we will be learning all about the digestive systems of different animals, including studying the diets of a variety of animals.

Information about what your child will learn this half term is on the other side of this sheet.

We look forward to working with you and your child. Ms Corales, Miss Sterling, Ms Farhana As writers, we will be basing our stories on the actions and behaviour of the Vikings. We will use drama to help us to understand the ways in which they lived their lives. Additionally, we will continue to read Skellig by David Almond and create our own versions of the story.
