Personal, Social & Emotional Development

In class we will be focusing on; following rules, making positive choices and learning to manage our feelings. We will also be encouraging the children to say when they do or do not need help.

Help your child by: Talking about emotions and describing your own feelings using a range of different words. When reading stories you can talk about the different characters, emotions and even suggest possible solutions to improve things.

Literacy

We will be encouraging the children to become confident writers and develop their sentence building skills with the use of finger spaces and full stops in their writing. In reading we will continue to read a range of books through our guided reading sessions and identify the difference between lower case and upper case letters.

Help your child by: Continue to read a range of books with your child. Show your child you are a reader and a writer by making sure they see you write shopping lists, messages and even your own stories! Help your child to distinguish between lower case and upper case letters by looking at lettering in books.

Expressive Arts and Design

Through learning about tastes around the world we will also be looking at different instruments and music from around the world. We will be learning new stories and using our drama skills to act them out.

Help your child by: Encourage your child to retell stories after reading a favourite book, draw characters from the stories, and perform songs to family and friends.



Communication and Language

We will be continuing to learn how to listen to our partners and respond to questions.

Help your child by: Speaking to your child using full sentences and a helping them to reply using the same.



Physical Development

We will be continuing our PE lessons and strengthening the use of our gross-motor and fine-motor skills through pushing, patting, throwing, catching and kicking.

Help your child by: Encouraging them to dress and undress themselves at home. We would also love to see some of the great games and activities you do with your children uploaded onto Tapestry so we can share these with their friends! Please bring spare clothes for your child to keep at school.
