ANTI- BULLYING WEEK AND ODD SOCKS DAY

The week beginning Monday 12th November is national Anti-Bullying Week organised by the Anti-Bullying Alliance; the theme this year is "Choose Respect." The children will be doing work throughout the week to identify what bullying is and showing them how to speak up and speak out if they are a victim of bullying or if they see bullying affecting others.

On **Monday 12th November** we are joining in with a national **"Odd Socks"** event to celebrate that everyone is unique and different. Please help your child to choose odd socks for the day. We hope this will help us spread a serious message in a fun way.

Please speak to your child about the work they are doing about anti-bullying and why it is important to stand up to bullying.

ATTENDANCE

Good attendance and punctuality is important for your children to make progress and to have good academic attainment throughout their school career. The better a child's academic attainment the better future career and learning opportunities they will have.

We cannot authorise family holiday during term time - please ensure that you check the school term times before you book any family holiday.

We currently have eight classes with attendance above 97% (Argentina, 96.7%, are just below) Bolivia 3, Chile 2, Colombia 2, El Salvador 6 and Espana 6. The three classes with the best attendance since the beginning of term are **Nicaragua 4 (98.0%)**, **Venezuela 5 (98.3%)** and **Mexico 4 (98.5%)** The overall attendance of Mexico class has improved in the past two weeks - well done.

A very well done to all of the classes who over the past two weeks have had **over 98%** attendance. Espana 6 (97.6%) and Colombia 2 (97.8%) are just below; five classes are above including **Argentina 3, Nicaragua 4, Venezuela 5 and Mexico 4.** Well done to **Chile 2** who have had an attendance of **99.3%** - very well done.

Across the school many children continue to have **100% attendance:**Reception -**20**; Year 1 – **25**; Year 2 - **31**; Year 3 - **23**; Year 4 - **36**; Year 5 - **33** & Year 6 - **33**.

A special mention to **Venezuela 5** who have 19 children and **Mexico 4** who have **20 children** with **100% attendance** - well done. All of the children with 100% attendance are still in line for the **Bronze certificate** this term as they strive for **Gold** at the end of year.
