

You should be listening to your child read for at least 25 minutes a day

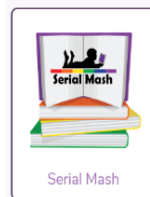
### Purple Mash

1. Log on to Purple Mash

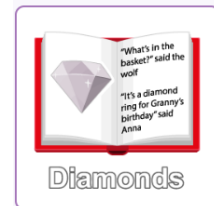


2. Once logged in, click

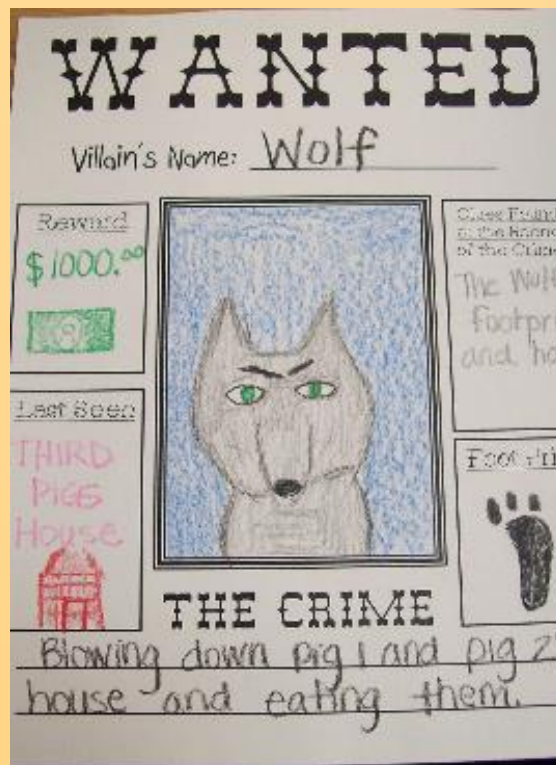
