

Plant Diary



For the Easter Holidays your project is to plant a seed and create a diary of all of the different stages of growth.

You can plant any seed of your choice. Here are some suggestions:

Tomato seeds, apple pips, peppers, beans or peas or plant the top of a carrot.



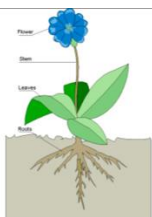
So, here is what you do.

1. Take an empty plastic bottle with no cap and cut it carefully lengthwise - you get 2 halves.
2. Take kitchen roll and cover the bottom of each half-bottle with a few layers (6-8).
3. Pour some water over the paper layers until it's wet completely, then tilt it bottleneck down to pour out excess water.
4. Put the seeds on the wet paper and slightly pin each seed down with a fingertip.
5. Place a plastic bag over the half-bottle to make sure that all moisture will stay inside.

Remember to water your plant regularly!

- In your book write the date you planted your seeds and write and draw pictures of how you planted your seeds.
- Every few days add notes, dates and pictures in your books on all of the changes you notice about the seeds.
- Draw/take pictures of the different changes.

When we come back to school, you can explain to your friends all about the growth of your plant!



Design a new plant that has never been seen before.

What will its leaves look like, what about the flower will be bright or spotty or striped?

Will it have a beautiful scent?
