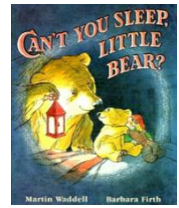
Below are some activities you can use when learning at home.

Which type is your favourite? What does it look like?

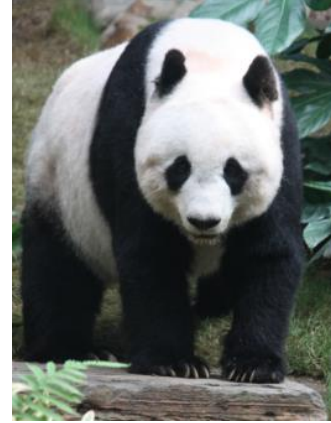
Where does it live? What does it eat? Why is it your favourite?
