Below are three writing activities for you to do this week.
Make sure you write at least a page for each piece.

Over the next 2 weeks, your writing will be based on the topic: **The Tudors**. This week, you will be researching, next week you will be writing!

Activity 1: Reading

The Tudors were a Welsh-English family that ruled England and Wales from 1485 to 1603, starting with the first monarch King **Henry VII** (1457–1509). The Tudors ruled for 118 years and Tudor England saw two of the strongest monarchs ever to sit on the English throne: **King Henry VIII** and his daughter **Queen Elizabeth I**.



We would like you to read about the Tudors, who they were and what they did. Here are some websites for you to look through. You can write notes if you would like, but we would like you to read and discuss your findings with an adult at home.
