


## Farm Animals

Make sure you show pictures that you have drawn in the clip. Post it on Tapestry.</p>	<p><b>Art</b></p> <p>Using recyclable materials make a model of a farm animal or a farm animal mask.</p> 
<p><b>Talk about...</b></p> <p>Imagine you went on a trip to the farm. What can you see around you? Which sounds can you hear? e.g. can you hear the chickens clucking? Can you see the horses trotting? Can you smell the hay in the barn?</p>	<p><b>Music</b></p> <p>Can you listen to the song 'Old Macdonald had a farm' and use instruments or utensils to tap along to the music?</p> <p>Can you copy the sound that different animals make?</p>
<p><b>Make up some farm animal names</b></p> <p>Imagine you are a farmer. Can you think of names that you would call each animal? For example, Percy the pig, Susie sheep etc. Can you think of a name beginning with H for a horse? Can you write it down?</p>	<p><b>Music</b></p> <p>Can you listen to the song 'Old Macdonald had a farm' and use instruments or utensils to tap along to the music?</p> <p>Can you copy the sound that different animals make?</p> <p>Counting to 10 with farm animals.</p> <p>Can you make a farm animal counting book?</p> <p>Make up some farm animal maths problems to test your family. E.g. If one chicken laid 3 eggs and the other laid 5 eggs, how many eggs are there altogether?</p>
<p><b>Shapes</b></p> <p>Cut out lots of shapes- squares, circles and triangles.
