



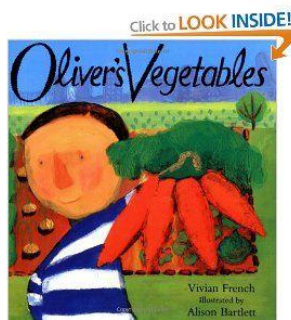

Maybe you can remember how we cared for our beans. What do we need, to make them healthy and grow bigger? What happens to them with no sunlight? Why do they need water? Maybe you can write your own story about Jack and the Beanstalk? You can try to label the different parts of a plant such as seed, flower, stem, leaves and root.</p>
<p><u>Art</u> Use a piece of card ,stick brown paper or tissue paper on the bottom for the earth. Then place some tiny beads or draw on some seeds. Pipe cleaners or draw on some roots. Straws for the stems and cut out some leaf shapes for the leaves. Paper cup cake wrappers for the flowers with beads or colour in for the seeds inside the flower. Label you art work. Roots seeds stem earth flowers petals Plant</p>  <p>Using forks or handprint create your own colourful plant/ use different vegetables to draw a plant.</p>  	<p><u>Talk about</u> How do we plant a seed? Find a seed at home and look for what plants need to grow? You can even attempt to label each part of a plant.</p>
<p><u>Music</u> Farmer plants the seeds YouTube https://youtu.be/cRhGOdgWllo Find some seeds put inside yogurt cartons, seal up and shake it about to make sounds.</p>	<p><u>Movement</u> Try curling up tight into a ball and imagine you are a seed. Slowly unravel upwards and imagine you are a plant beginning to grow. Unravel more and stand on your tip toes and reach up high.</p>

Stretch your arms above your head and place your hands together to make a flower.
Now sway from side to side and imagine you are a flower blowing in the wind.
Now fall back down to the ground and start again!

Maths

Explore and go walking to see and spot how many different plants you can find. Make a Tally chart of all the different plants.

How many did you spot altogether?

Which one did you spot the most of and which the least?

Try taking the biggest amount from the total and then the least amount from your total. Try to write this as a number sentence.

See if you find a dandelion and count how many petals it has. Then see if you can spot a fluffy puff dried dandelion and see how many puffs you need before it disappears.
