Rain

Rain is needed so that plants can grow.

Snow

Snow is frozen rain.



It has to be freezing cold to snow.



Some snow can be moulded into shapes like snowmen.



At the North and South Pole there is snow on the ground all year round.

Some snow is very wet and slushy.

The snow melts when the air becomes warmer.
