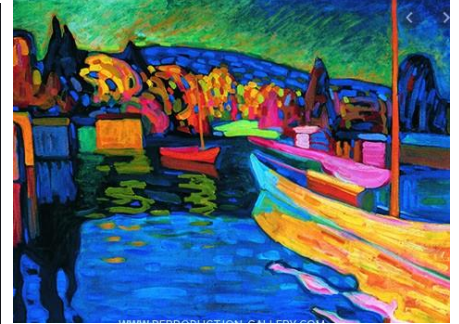


Art, week starting 13th July 2020



Wassily Kandinsky (1866 – 1944) was a Russian painter, printmaker and art theorist. He was one of the most important 20th-century artists. He was a major figure in modern art and created some of the first modern abstract works. His art changed several times during his life. Below are some of his different pieces which show some of his different styles. Which do you like best? Why?
