- Years 3,4 & 5 will finish at 1:45


TIER 2

You will no doubt have heard in the media this week about the government announcement for new COVID restrictions in London. The new restrictions mean from the 17th October at midnight, London will be ranked at high (tier 2), meaning households are not allowed to mix indoors anywhere in London. ATTENDANCE

Overall attendance is 96.1%, with Mexico 4 having the best attendance of 98.4%. Argentina 3, Colombia 2, Costa Rica 1, Cuba 1 and Reception Paraguay all have attendance above 97%. Nicaragua 4 have only 6 children who have been absent since the beginning of term.

11 classes last week had an attendance above 97%; the best attendances were Chile 2, Mexico 4 and Venezuela 5 all above 99%. These three classes and Argentina 3 had only 1 child who was absent last week.
