ATTENDANCE

Overall attendance is currently 96.7% since the beginning of term. Attendance this week has been good, with an overall figure of 96.8%. Chile 2 class had an attendance of 100% this week which is outstanding. Mexico 4 class have an attendance of 98.7% since the beginning of term.

We are continuing with our systems for maintaining good attendance including calls home, meetings with families and asking for Educational Welfare support for the small number of children and families whose attendance is a concern to us.

We are very clear that your child needs to be in school to learn both academically and socially if they are to flourish and thrive in later life.

COVID 19

Please ensure that you follow the current lockdown guidance that came in to effect on Thursday 5th November. Can we ask that to help minimise the risk of spreading infection that you do not congregate in groups around the gate and do not block the footpath for other users.

Also continue to wear your masks when dropping off and picking up to help keep everyone safe. Can we also ask that to reduce numbers only one adult comes to drop off and pick up.

To help keep staff and children safe in schools we are increasing ventilation by having windows open throughout the day. Your child may wish to wear items such as a long sleeve t-shirt underneath their uniform if they are feeling cold during this period in school.
