### PARENTS EVENING

Thursday 10th December is Parents Evening. The meeting will be held online

On **Tuesday 8th December** you will receive a link to the meeting via your email account. Please be prompt and come to the meeting at your agreed meeting time; the meetings will be a maximum of ten minutes.

At your appointed time the class teacher will admit you to the meeting and share the information with you about your child.

### **ATTENDANCE**

On **Tuesday 15th December** we will have our attendance celebration assembly. At this assembly, all children who have **100%attendance** for this term will receive a **bronze attendance certificate**.

Over the year, any child with 100% attendance in 1 term will receive a bronze certificate; children with 100% attendance over **2 terms** receive a **silver certificate**. **Gold certificates** are awarded to children with **100%** attendance for the **whole school year**, from September to July.

Current school attendance is 96.8%. Well done Chile2, Costa Rica 1, El Salvador 6, Nicaragua 4 & Reception Paraguay who have attendance over 97%. A special mention for Cuba 1 who have an attendance of 97.8% since September.

School attendance last week was **96.9%**; **Mexico 4** had the best attendance with **99%**.

### **BLACK POUND DAY**

Where will you be spending your money in support of **Black Pound Day** on **Saturday 5th December**?

Our recommendation for Black Pound Day this month is **Chuku's**, located at 274, High Road, Tottenham, N15. This is the world's first Nigerian tapas restaurant. Founded by a Nigerian brother and sister duo, Chuku's restaurant has all the flavours of Nigeria with an interesting twist.

### FREE SCHOOL MEAL HOLIDAY VOUCHERS

If you are entitled to **free school meals** we will be emailing you a supermarket voucher on the **Monday 14**<sup>th</sup> **December** worth **£30 PER child** for the Christmas period. We can only issue a voucher to those families who are confirmed eligible by this date.

If you are in Reception or Year 1, you currently get free school meals under the universal offer, this does **NOT** entitle you to a supermarket voucher. Please check your eligibility on-line at: <a href="https://pps.lgfl.org.uk/">https://pps.lgfl.org.uk/</a>, once confirmed we can add you to the you voucher list.

### TIER 2

You will be aware that earlier this week, England came out of a Covid related lockdown. Please check for information for what this means for you and your family and how to help keep everyone within the community safe and well. We have posters around the school perimeter outlining what Tier 2 means.

Key points to note are that you should not be mixing with different households indoors and meetings outdoors should be kept to a maximum of 6 people.

Schools continue to be open and anyone who is able to work from home should continue to do so.

We also remind you to please wear your face covering when dropping off and collecting children from school.

### **CHRISTMAS**

Due to current Covid restrictions and guidance about gatherings and singing we will not be having any communal celebrations this year. The children will learn the Christmas Story to help them to understand the significance of Christmas to Christians.

At the end of term we will be posting links onto the website to celebrate the music teaching that has happened this term.

Key Stage 2 children (years 3—6) will have the opportunity to watch an online theatre production of **A Christmas Carol** performed by the Old Vic on the afternoon of **Wednesday 16th December.** They will also read and learn the story beforehand so they know this classic Christmas tale well.

Christmas dinner and Christmas Jumper Day is Friday 11th December. If your child is usually packed lunch, please inform the office if you would like your child to have Christmas dinner on this day.

## DIWALI

Children have recently learnt about Diwali. They used clay to sculpt their own Diva Lamps which were then painted and decorated. They also created Rangoli Patterns using beans, rice and dry herbs.

### YEAR 2 SCIENCE

In science, year 2 have been learning how to classify animals and discuss whether they are **carnivores**, **omnivores herbivores**. They made frogs out of playdough.

A real frog would be able to communicate, jump, swim, eat, digest and drink.

Some science questions from Ms Mackey. Can the playdough frog do these things? How would you classify the playdough frog? Why?
