BRONZE ATTENDANCE CERTIFICATES

This week we have been celebrating the children who have had excellent attendance throughout this term. Some of the certificate winners are pictured here, others can be seen on the school website.

We are delighted to report that we gave **135** Bronze Attendance Certificates this week; up from 77 this time last year. Bronze certificates celebrate children who have had **100% attendance** for one term.

Puerto Rico 5 and Chile 2 each had 11 children with 100% attendance: incredibly Nicaragua 4 had 14 children who have not missed a single day of school since September - very well done.

Children who did not get a bronze certificate this term can still earn a Bronze Certificate with 100% attendance next term; those who have received a Bronze Certificate are eligible for possibly receiving a Silver and then Gold certificate with

continued 100% attendance over the coming terms.

Chloe in year 1 continues to keep up the family tradition of not having any absence from school; she has not been absent since she began at Alexandra and her brother Jake was here for 7 years without a single day of absence - truly remarkable.


Repeat winners of the Bronze Certificate include **William**, **Elion** and **Misha**.

ATTENDANCE

Overall school attendance for the term is **96.8%** which we are really pleased with. We appreciate that this attendance is as a result of the families who are supporting us in understanding the importance of school and education. This is even more important with the year we have had, with the enforced school closure we experienced due to lockdown between March and July.

TIER 3 RESTRICTIONS

You will be aware that London was recently moved into tier 3 restrictions in an attempt to try and minimise the spread of COVID.

This means that you should not mix indoors with different households and only meet outside in public places (not private gardens) in groups of no more than 6 people.

We encourage all people to wear masks and to think carefully before you mix with others. This is to help to keep the whole community safe including your friends, relatives and loved ones.

We have been fortunate that we have not had to close the school or to send classes home to isolate. This can only be expected to continue into the new year if all people follow the guidance and use a cautious sensible approach to celebrating Christmas, irrespective of the government allowing some loosening of the rules for a short period of time in the middle of the holiday period.
