### **FULL SCHOOL OPENING**

We are delighted that from **Monday 8th March** all children will be returning to school after the latest government lockdown.

We appreciate that the past two months have been challenging. For parents and carers supporting home learning and for children missing the daily routine of learning in class alongside your teachers and peers.

Details of start and end times were sent last week to families including information about which gate to bring your child. The letter also informed you that we will doing temperature checks with children in the morning and children will be sanitising and washing hands throughout the day.

Guidance for primary school currently states that masks are not required for children when in school; we will be ensuring good ventilation in school by keeping windows and doors open.

We do ask that when you arrive promptly to drop off and pick up that you do not block the footpath and that you do wear a mask while waiting with your child alongside the school perimeter wall. It is imperative that you also maintain social distancing when you are dropping off and picking up to help reduce the spread of infection.
