END OF YEAR CELEBRATIONS

I am sure that many of you were waiting for the government announcement on Monday regarding the next steps to move the country further out of lockdown measures.

The guidance to restrict gatherings of large groups and wait to ease restrictions at least until 19th July has informed our decision as a school as to how to celebrate the end of year. We have, since the government announcement, been receiving further guidance from the Department for Education, Public Health England and Haringey.
