Year 4 have been exploring the mechanics of cars. First, they created their own chassis, wheels and axles. Then they designed and created cars which used a sail to power them. The next step was to create cars which were balloon powered.

After they had created them, they tested them to see how effective the wind was at powering them. Finally, they evaluated the design of their cars - seeing what worked well and how they can be improved next time.


