Welcome back! We have had a smooth start into Year I and are excited to watch this year unfold. There are lots of fantastic activities and learning that we have planned for this year. We are not able to do this without working alongside you, collaboratively, as a team.

As writers, we are continuously trying to improve our handwriting and pencil control. We will be reading and retelling simple stories, understanding that all stories have a beginning, middle and end. We will explore characters, setting and the plot. The children will become confident writers whilst developing their level of inquisitiveness, imagination and originality.

As mathematicians we will be using mental strategies for addition and subtraction and working towards written methods. 15 + 5 = /16 - 3 =. We will also learn about 'place value. This is the position of each number - ones, tens, hundreds, etc. Our focus in times tables is to count in 2's, 5's, 10's off by heart and out of sequence.

As scientists, we will be learning all about 'animals including humans'. We will be investigating our senses and body parts of humans/animals. We will also be sorting animals according to their diet and appearance (carnivores, herbivores, omnivores / amphibians, reptiles, fish etc).
