STEAM WEEK

Our engineers worked hard to plan, design, create, test and evaluate their models. Our structural engineers in EYFS-Year 2 created bridges. Marley from Chile class enthusiastically said, "When making a bridge, it is important to have strong lolly sticks so that it won't break if I rolled a car over it. I used triangle patterns and tape."

In Year 3 and 4, our green engineers made floating gardens. "We made floating gardens using recycled materials – this helps with climate change. My group made sure it floated by putting the lids on the bottles so water wouldn't come in and make it sink. We made our floating garden balanced on both sides. In real life, floating gardens help countries around the world when it floods." Melina (Bolivia Class)

Year 5 and 6 worked as automotive and electrical engineers. Renaya (El Salvador Class) enjoyed STEAM week and learnt so much about the engineering and design process. "Making the electrical car taught me about complete circuits and that creating something is all about trial and error. It was fun changing and improving my car. Also, we learnt about black female engineers in the automotive industry. It has inspired me to become an engineer – but a software engineer".

The children in nursery looked at images of Tower Bridge before having the chance to draw their own interpretation of Tower Bridge on a large piece of paper as a whole class. The children then split off into two groups and used different kinds of building materials to bring their designs to life.

MORNING GATE

As we continue to amend our daily practice to keep all of our school community as safe as possible during these Covid times, we have now reviewed our start of day procedures for the gate opening.

From **Tuesday 19th April**, all external gates will open at **8:40**, children can access the site at any gate and walk to their lining up space in the playground. Teachers will be in the playground to collect the children and take them up to class at **8:45**.
