BUILDING WORKS

After half term, Haringey Council will begin major building works on the school. The works are scheduled to run from May to the end of November and will see much needed refurbishment works taking place. The first phase of the work will take place during the upcoming May half term and will consist of scaffolding being erected throughout the site around both buildings.

The works will include replacing windows and roofing, as well as improving heating, plumbing and electrics throughout the school. It is hoped that much of the work will take place during the summer holidays and evenings; it is however inevitable works will take place during the school day. We will work closely with the contractor Mulalley, and Haringey to try to keep any disruption to the absolute minimum.
