How to look after your class book

Is your book corner messy? Are you tired of having to look deeply for your books? If so, read this set of instructions to learn how to keep your book corner tidy

Firstly, it is important to place the book in the correct area, the book in the correct area, especially when you return it. For example don't put grey in time and magenta in brown. This is important because if books are in their correct place, you can easily land them. easily find them.
