START & END OF DAY

Gates open at **8:40** in the morning for children to come into school. Teachers collect the children from the playground for learning to begin in class at **8:45**.

Please ensure that your children are on time in the morning so they do not miss out on learning.

From **Monday 12th September**, at the end of the day, we will open the gates at **3:00** for families to come into the playground.

Children will be in the playground at **3:10** for collection. Some classes will be in different parts of the playground; please ask a member of staff if you are unsure where your child is to be collected from.

MEET THE TEACHER

On **Tuesday 13th September** families will have the opportunity to come into school to meet their child's teacher. The meetings will take place in class at **3:30**.

Teachers will outline the learning expectations for the year and give information about how you can support your child's learning. These meetings should be approximately 25 minutes.

Teachers will remain available until 4:30 to see parents who have multiple siblings and want the opportunity to meet each of their children's teachers.

Please note that the majority of **visits take place in September** and some require you to book a visit. The information can also be found on our <u>website</u>.
