EYFS CELEBRATE CHINESE NEW YEAR

Recently EYFS learnt about the celebration of Chinese New Year. They painted beautiful cherry blossom trees, using paint and tissue paper, they also made noodles using string and scissors.

The children also tasted the delicious savoury snack prawn crackers and made their own Chinese lanterns, exploring texture and colour using coloured rice.

The children explored Chinese dancing, songs, stories and food. They watched a video on how to make Chinese stir fry, then created a list of ingredients in their literacy lesson.

The children washed and cut the vegetables, using chopsticks to eat their delicious meal. The stir fry was a big hit - the children thoroughly enjoyed it.
