Recently staff met with a number of children who volunteered to attend a meeting to discuss ideas to support families affected by the earthquakes in Turkey and Syria.

Ideas included donating items such as clothing, food and baby products, as well as fund raising ideas such as a cake sale, non-uniform day and lots

more. Ideas will be presented to the senior leadership team for further discussion and agreement. We will share the ideas with the school community once dates and ideas have been agreed.

Many thanks to those of you who came along to the Syria & Turkey Coffee Morning and shared your personal experiences. We will be

holding a **Turkish & Syria Food Evening** on **Tuesday March 14th,** from 3:15.

The school community have so far donated £1154.55 towards the appeal for this tragedy. We will be donating this to **The Red Cross Appeal Fund.** Thank you to you all for your amazing generosity at this difficult time.



Recently, Alexandra children have been given the opportunity to visit Wood Green Library. All classes will have the opportunity to visit before the end of the summer term. (Thank you, **Ms Kennedy** for organising this).

Children had the opportunity to complete membership forms prior to the visit so so they received a library card to take away. This means that they are able to borrow books, which is very exciting!

Children can BORROW up to **15** books on each visit; they can keep those books for up to 3 weeks, if they wish to carry on reading those books they need to RENEW them. Once they have finished enjoying the books they are RETURNED to the library. You can then borrow a further fifteen books!

Families who haven't signed up for a library card can visit the library at any point and complete a membership form.

The School Council will lead on this project; we will keep you informed as the project develops.


CHESS CHALLENGE
