#### STORYTIME IN SCHOOLS

Alexandra Primary have been taking part in Farshore's major new '**Storytime in Schools**' research project to test the impact of daily story time on children's attainment and attitudes to reading.

We are **one of 20 schools** from across the UK who are participating in the **twelve-week study**, with children in **Years 3, 4 and 5** experiencing a daily story time for one term.

The study will see teachers read to children for at least **20 minutes each day**, purely for enjoyment with no formal teaching attached, to measure the impact on children's motivation to read for pleasure independently.

We recently has STEAM Week with the celebration of the work at the Science Fair where our pupils celebrated their scientific and engineering skills.
