ATTENDANCE

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Continuing to be impressive, Bolivia also have the best attendance since the beginning of term with 97.3%.

At the end of term we will be celebrating the children who have had 100% attendance since September. They will receive a Bronze Certificate to mark this significant achievement.

Each term we reward 100% attendance with certificates; if a child has two terms of 100% attendance they will receive a Silver Certificate. If they manage the whole school year, they will receive a Gold Certificate.
