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#### CLASS ASSEMBLIES

Our 2024 class assemblies began this week with Colombia 2.

#### YEAR 2 JOURNEYS

To launch their new topic of Journeys, year 2 went on a journey around our local area last week. They started at Alexandra Primary and set off on a circular route, through the tunnel and into Ally Pally, finishing in Barratt Gardens.

They took pictures on the way of different features, asking whether they were physical features or human features. In Barratt Gardens, they also explored habitats as they are beginning a new topic of Living Things and Their Habitats in science.

Year 2 proved they are both geographers and scientists.

#### **ATTENDANCE**

All research shows that **children who attend school regularly get better educational outcomes which in turn bring better job and income prospects**. With this in mind, we have been disappointed with the school attendance in the two weeks before the Christmas break and the first week after; there are a large number of children who did not attend in that time and who now have an attendance figure of less than 90%.

We have thirteen weeks holiday a year which is why we cannot authorise time away from school around holiday times.

It is **parents legal responsibility** to ensure that their child attends school regularly; if they do not, the Educational Welfare Service may bring about **court proceedings**.

School overall attendance since September is 94.8%; our school target is 96%. Lets work together to achieve this target. Remember - every day counts.

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#### PARENTS WORKSHOP

**Parents of children in year 2, 3 & 4** are welcome to attend a workshop on how to support their children to learn Spanish.

It will be in the school house on Wednesday 31st January, at 9:00am.

#### SPACE...
